English As A Second Language Teacher - Role Description

The English as a Second Language teacher:

1. Works to provide an educational program to students whose primary language(s) of the home, is/are other than English, and who may therefore require additional services in order to develop their individual potential within British Columbia's school system. Some students speak variations of English that differ significantly from the English used in the broader Canadian society and in school; they may require ESL support.
2. Works to achieve the goal of English as a Second Language education to assist students to become proficient in English, to develop intellectually and as citizens, and to enable them to achieve the expected learning outcomes of the provincial curriculum.
3. Provides support to ESL students in the areas of language proficiency, intellectual development and citizenship.
4. Works collaboratively to identify, plan and provide services to ESL students.
5. Provides ongoing assessment.
6. Reports the progress of ESL students.
