The 2009/2010 committee existed to support Board Goal 1.1 School & Classroom Culture *Provide clear expectations and support for the continuing development of safe, inclusive, caring, respectful, and collaborative school and classroom learning environment.*

The proposal is for the Committee to continue to meet during the 2010-2011 school year. The Committee will maintain the current structure and direction.

Membership for 2010-2011:

- 2 Board of Education – two representatives, one who will serve as Chair.
- 2 DPAC – two representatives
- 4 Parent/Community representatives – named by the committee. The availability of the committee membership will be advertised as follows: local newspapers, District and School & websites, and school newsletters when available. Parent/Community representatives selected will provide a broad range of views and representation.
- 4 Student Representatives – from the secondary school that the meeting is held in

- 1 CUPE - one representatives
- 2 SSTA – two representatives
- 2 Principals/VPs – two representatives
- 1 Director of Instruction (District Coordinator – Social Responsibility)
- 1 Superintendent (or designate)

All meetings will be public meetings.

Meetings will be held monthly, last Tuesday of the month school is in session, commencing at 6:30 p.m., unless otherwise arranged by the Chair.

Meetings will be held in schools on a rotating basis, in Squamish, Whistler, and Pemberton.

Minutes will be taken at each meeting and posted on the District website.

As this is a Board Advisory Committee, the Committee Chair will be a Trustee, who will report to the Board. The Committee Chair will bring recommendations forward to the Board, for consideration.
