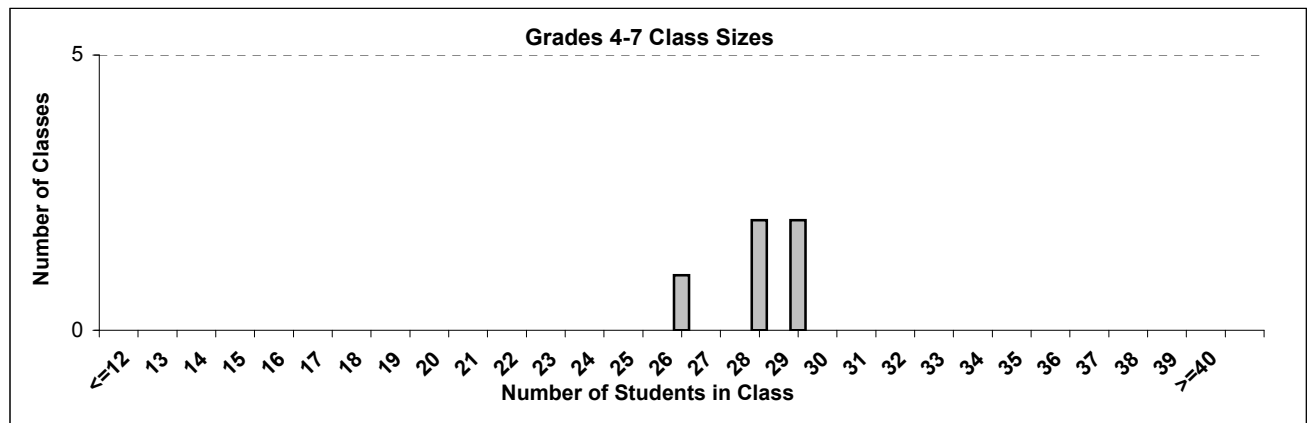

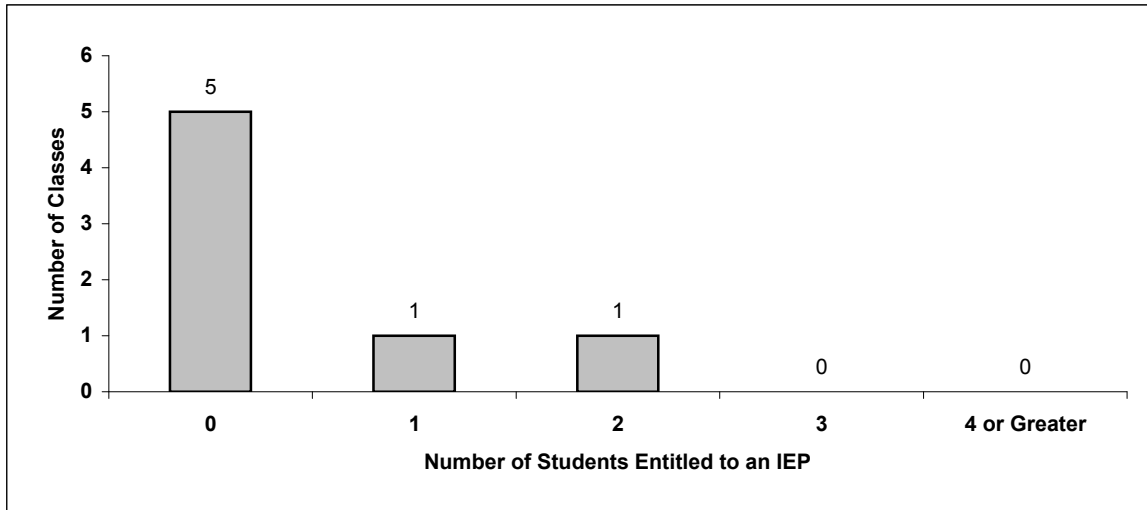

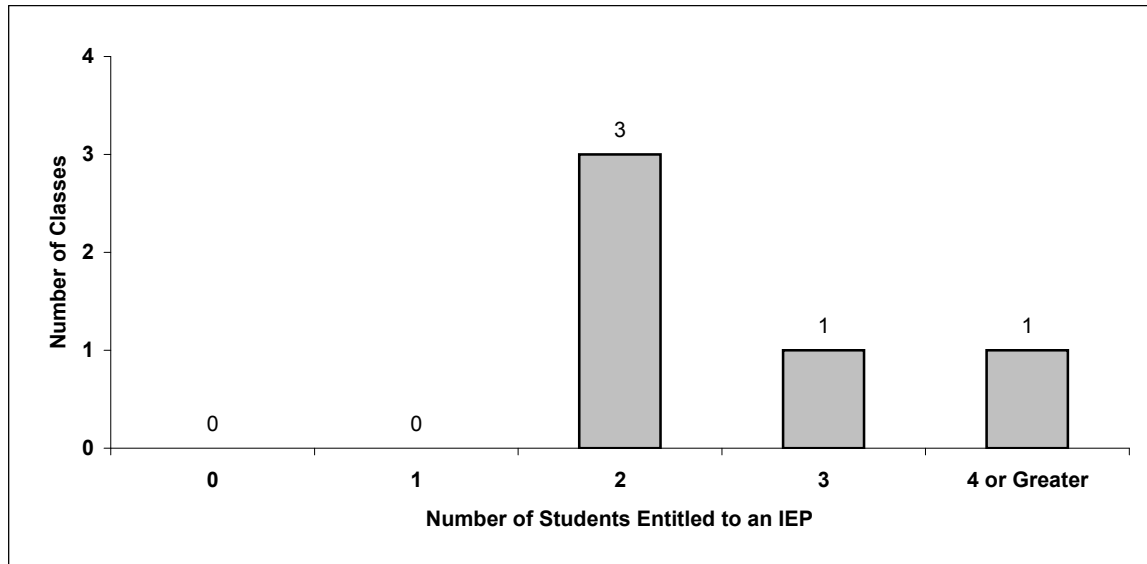

Grades 4-12 - Number of Classes in School with 'X' Number of Students Entitled to an IEP

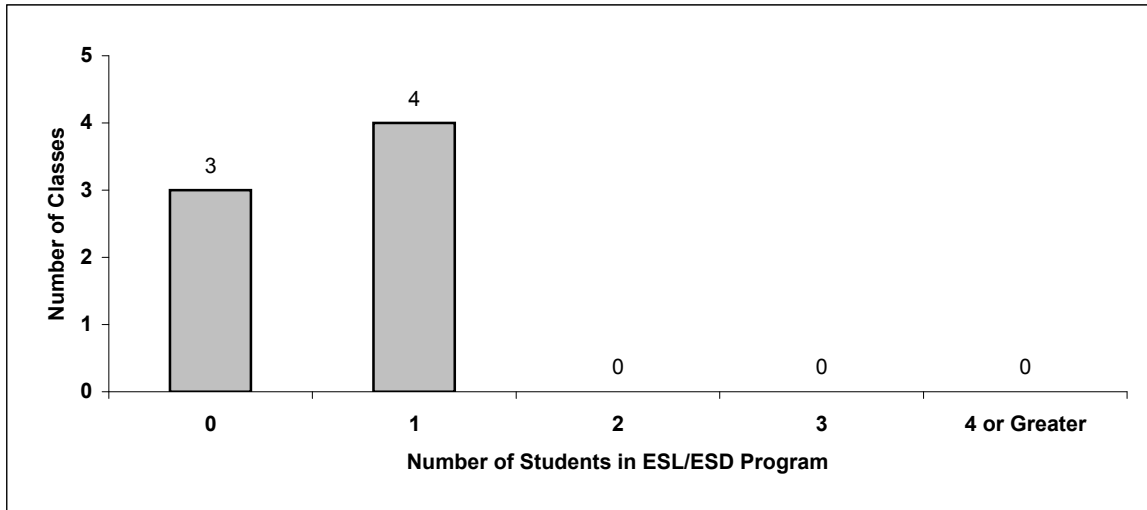


# Students in English as a Second Language/Dialect (ESL/ESD) Program

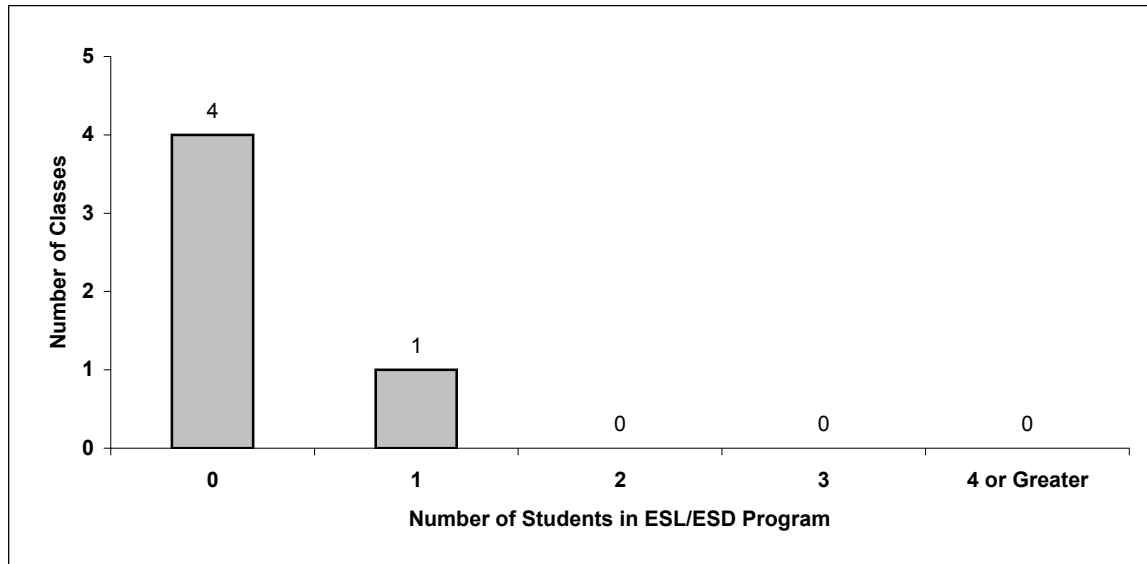

## Glossary

Terms	Definitions / Notes
<b>Average Education Assistants Hours per Week</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The average number of Education Assistant (EA) hours per week, per class, at this school. Minutes are reported to two decimal points; for example, 1 hour 30 minutes is reported as 1.50 hours.</li> </ul>
<b>English as a Second Language/Dialect (ESL/ESD) Program</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A program offered to students whose primary language(s) is/are other than English, and who may require additional services.</li> </ul>
<b>Gifted Student</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A student who has exceptional gifts or talents and is defined as Category P in the Special Education Performance Reporting Groups.</li> </ul>
<b>Grade</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The assigned grade of a student on September 30.</li> </ul>
<b>KH</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Kindergarten half-time</li> </ul>
<b>KF</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Kindergarten full-time</li> </ul>
<b>Number of Students</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Student population is calculated by headcount.</li> </ul>
<b>Student</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A person enrolled in a BC school. Student populations are calculated by headcount. Students include all adult and school-aged persons who are working toward a certificate of graduation.</li> </ul>
<b>Student Entitled to an Individual Education Plan</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A student for whom an Individual Education Plan (IEP) must be designed under the Individual Education Plan order, Ministerial Order 638/95.</li> </ul>
