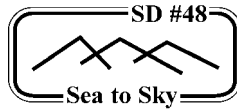


EDUCATION PLAN 2009 – 2011

GOAL 1.1 SCHOOL & CLASSROOM CULTURE

Provide clear expectations and support for the continuing development of safe, inclusive, caring, respectful, and collaborative school and classroom learning environments.

OBJECTIVE by June, 2011

The number of SD48 Grade 3/ 4, 7, 10 and 12 students participating in the MoE’s annual Satisfaction Survey in the section on “Safety”, will respond to the following questions ...

Percent of students responding “all of the time” or “many times”:

- Do you feel safe at School? 100%
- At school, are you bullied, teased, or picked on ? 0%
- Do you know what your school’s expectations are for student behaviour? 100%

GOAL 1.2 INSTRUCTION

Promote the organization and delivery of instruction in classrooms, schools and the community in ways that enable student responsibility for learning, active engagement in tasks of learning, and success.

OBJECTIVE by June, 2011

Use ‘Assessment for Learning’ practices to achieve the following targets:

1. SCHOOL COMPLETION RATES

- 100% graduating from Grade 12 with Dogwood or School Completion Certificate

2. LITERACY (Reading):

- 100% meeting/exceeding Reading for Information expectations in Grades 3 using BC Performance Standards - Reading for Information.

3. NUMERACY (Problem-Based Numeracy):

- 100% meeting/exceeding Problem-Based Numeracy expectations in Grades 2 and 6 using Assessment for Numeracy in Education Evaluation (ANIE)
