#### Level 1 - Clothing and Textiles - (Students that have never taken clothing and textiles)

Supplies will be provided for the following projects that will take anywhere from 7 - 13 weeks:

Bean Bag Frog, Tote Bag, Flannel Boxer Shorts/PJ's (If your child wishes to make full length PJ's they should bring 2.5 metres of a suitable (non-stretch) fabric, Child's Stretch T-shirt with set in sleeves.

Additional projects will need to be chosen by the student with patterns, materials and notions to be brought from home.

#### Level 2 - Clothing and Textiles - (Students that have completed Level 1)

Each student will be responsible for choosing their own patterns and providing all fabric and notions required to complete their chosen projects. School projects are also available to be completed for which all materials will be supplied, however, students will not be able to take these projects home as materials from these projects will be re-used for successive projects, donated to charity or sold to raise money for the textiles program.

The Ministry of Education has directed that schools cannot charge course fees, except for a student activity fee of \$20.00. \$3 of this will be refunded at the end of the school year when the student's lock is returned.

In addition, our teachers have found that the Language Arts and French programs are greatly enhanced by student use of consumable workbooks. The total cost of these workbooks is approximately \$40.00, however if the workbook is returned unmarked, the deposit of \$40.00 will be returned to the student.
